



CHARITY/FUNDRAISING POLICY

Queen of the South Football Club have a role to play in supporting well-being within our local communities. This includes supporting and promoting the role of local charities. Our chosen charity for season 2020-21 will be Cash for Kids alongside the Queen of the South Community Trust (KGV Trust). The Community Trust engages in numerous projects and initiatives to support the local community, using the Queen of the South branding to add to our already significant charity work. We will also recognise many other worthwhile causes in our area on a case by case basis.

Queen of the South will support good causes in our local communities through the provision of match vouchers including family vouchers and offering bucket collections at a certain number of home fixtures. Vouchers can be ordered and collected at the main reception at Palmerston Park Dumfries. You will need to apply in writing on headed paper providing your charity's registered number. Bucket collections can be arranged in the same way or by telephoning 01387 254853. We must note these are limited in availability.

Stadium tours can be arranged for registered charity groups.

The Club would stress that any merchandise purchased and signed will be charged at current rates. The Club would like to stress this follows the trend of most clubs throughout the UK.
